



## To subscribe for the French Social Security system ...

I enter my personal data and I upload the supporting documents into the dedicated site!

First of all I register on the dedicated site: [etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr](http://etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr)

I create my personal user account

- ✓ Passport / identity card
- ✓ Residence permit
- ✓ Full copy of the birth certificate with filiations / document issued by the Consulate
- ✓ Certificate of registration for the current academic year
- ✓ Certificate of parental authorization (for students under 16)
- ✓ IBAN number
- ✓ Additional documents according to the country of origin



I upload the mandatory supporting documents



I download my provisional certificate of affiliation to the social security coverage



I upload the missing or invalid supporting documents through my personal user account



I download my final certificate of affiliation to the social security coverage

Once I have achieved the affiliation procedure, I carry out complementary actions in order to get reimbursements more easily and more quickly:

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**Opening of a personal user account** on [ameli.fr](http://ameli.fr) or through the ameli mobile app



**Requesting for the "carte vitale"** (health insurance card) by providing the following supporting documents: ID photo and ID documents



**Appointment of a referring general practitioner** when visiting him for the first time: with my GP I fill in the form "Déclaration de choix du médecin traitant"
